Campus Dining Meal Plans

In order to meet your campus dining needs, we have designed the following meal plans for the new academic year. Meal plans are purchased through the Office of Student Affairs in the Administration Building. If you need to make a change in your dining plan selection, you may do so during the first two weeks of the semester.

- **19 Meal Plan plus \$50 in Flex Dining Dollars**
- **15 Meal Plan plus \$100 in Flex Dining Dollars**
- **10 Meal Plan plus \$150 Flex Dining Dollars**
- **100 Block Meal Plan with no Flex Dining Dollars**

Meal Cards

Purchase of a Campus Dining Meal Plan allows you to use your student ID as your meal card which will give you purchasing power equivalent to the plan you selected.

Here is how it works:

On a 19 meal plan you may eat a meal in the Dining Commons Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner Monday through Friday and Brunch and Dinner on Saturday and Sunday. For the other meal plans you may have one meal per meal period up to the total for the week. Meals are not carried over from week to week. A new week begins with Monday morning.

The new 100 block meal plan allows you to select meals as many times as you like during a meal plan, including inviting a guest to join you up to 100 meals per semester. The 100 block plan is for one semester and your meal balance carries over from week to week, but not from fall to spring semester.

Dietary Requirements & Sick Trays

Sick trays are also available for students with a meal plan. If you are feeling under the weather and would like to order a sick tray, contact your Residence Hall staff or the school nurse and we will work with them to order sick trays.

Dining Policies & Procedures

One of our main goals is to provide a pleasant, clean, comfortable and satisfying dining experience. In order to meet this goal, we ask for your assistance with the following procedures:

- Remember that other than your ice cream cone, no food or dishes may be removed from the dining areas. Fruit and other items may be purchased to take with you.
- Remember that you must present your student ID each time to access your meal plan. Meal plans are non-transferable.
- Dining Commons meals are all-you-care-to-eat. Take as much food as you will eat and do not hesitate to come back for seconds. Do your best not to waste food and resources.
- Please bus your table when you have finished your meal and be considerate of the next diner.

Welcome, Guests

Have a guest over for dinner! You are welcome to bring a friend or family member for any meal. Guest meal prices are as follows:

Except for the 100 Block meal plan, you may not use one of your meals for a guest. You may use your Flex Dining Dollars to purchase a guest meal in the Dining Commons.

FAQs

How do I purchase a meal plan?

Your meal plan is automatically added to your bill when you live on campus. Commuter students may purchase a meal plan in the Student Affairs Office in the Administration Building.

How do I change my meal plan?

Meal plans may be adjusted through the second week of each semester. Please see the staff in the Student Affairs Office in the Administration Building to make your changes.

Do my extra meals roll over from week to week?

Not unless you are on the 100 block meal plan. All other meal plans reset on Monday morning.

How long do I have to use my Flex Dining Dollars?

If you purchase a meal plan for the spring semester, any Flex Dining Dollars you have remaining from the fall semester will roll over. All Flex Dining Dollars expire on the last day of classes for the spring semester.

How can I purchase extra Flex Dining Dollars?

Flex Dining Dollars expire as described above, but you may purchase Braves Bucks on a declining balance plan. Braves Bucks are valid as long as your ID is valid.

What if I miss a meal due to athletics practice?

We proudly support the Braves and Lady Braves teams and work closely with your coaches and the practice schedule as well as pre-game and traveling squad meals.

Seconds Anyone?

You never have to be too shy to ask for seconds with our Campus Dining Program. Our generous policy allows for a second helping of many menu favorites. All you have to do is ask! Please note, however, there are some exceptions to our seconds policy including when we are having a specialty dinner such as a Steak Night. You will only be allowed one of the main entrees, but as much as you care to on everything else. Our all-you-care-to-eat program does not include food taken out of the Dining Commons. We do allow you to finish your ice cream cone on the way to class, but all other foods must be eaten in the dining area.

Lost Your Meal Card?

You are required to present your student ID every time you come for a meal or want to use your Flex Dining Dollars. Meal plans are not transferable and only you are allowed to present your student ID. Should you lose your student ID, report it immediately to the office of Student Affairs in the Administration Building. Your card will be deactivated and a new one will be issued for a nominal fee.

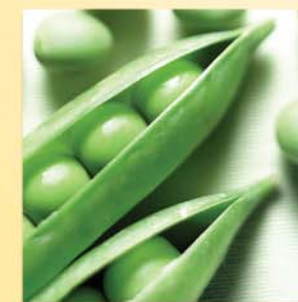
